Offer of Placement and Enrollment Contract

_____ is offered placement at Louisville Classical Academy (LCA) for the 2009 - 2010 academic year, subject to the terms and conditions herein and in the LCA Community Handbook for 2009 - 2010 (Handbook) which is incorporated by reference in its entirety into this contract. The Academy Tuition Policy is set forth on page 7 of the Handbook.

To accept the Offer of Placement and enroll the above student in LCA, both parents, guardians, or other persons responsible for tuition should read all the provisions of this Contract, including the Handbook, complete the required information, and sign and return this Contract to Louisville Classical Academy at 6902 Wolf Pen Branch Road, Prospect, KY 40059. The contract must be accompanied by a Registration Deposit of \$100 for students enrolling in the full Core Program or \$25 per class for students enrolling in individual courses.

A student is enrolled when this Contract has been delivered to LCA and its receipt acknowledged by written correspondence. No amendment to this contract and no alteration or addition to the printed terms hereof will be effective without prior written approval of LCA.

PROGRAM SELECTION AND TUITION CALCULATION

FULL CORE PROGRAM

The full Core Program includes the appropriate level of study in Language Arts (including Greek and Recitation), Mathematics, Science, History, Latin (all grades) or French (Upper School only), Foundations and Fine Arts. The Core Program starts at 8:15 a.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays; it concludes at 3:45 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays and at 4:15 p.m. on Wednesdays.

Acceptance of Handbook Terms and Policies

As a learning community on the scale of an extended family, relationships between the Academy's teachers, students, and parents have a profound impact on our school. The Academy supports those relationships with a Handbook that is a product of extensive deliberation by our faculty and made a part of this Offer of Placement and Contract. Parents are asked to review its terms prior to signing this document.

Especially, the Covenants on pages 13 - 15 for teachers, students, and parents call each of us to reflect on the reasonable needs and expectations of each other. The Tuition Policy on page 7 is grounded in the faculty's moral integrity, good will, a concern for each student's best interests, and a willingness to trust that families drawn to its program will respond in kind. That response includes an agreement by parents to provide written notice of any issues that lead to consideration of withdrawal, to cooperate with the faculty in resolving the issue, and to allow a reasonable period of time and not less than two weeks for resolution to occur. In order for a student to be withdrawn in good standing, parents must have complied with this agreement, and the account must be settled in full.

At the Family Orientation scheduled for Monday, August 17th, parents and students will be led through a review of the Handbook's terms, as well as any additions or revisions that may emerge from ongoing preparation for the 2009 - 2010 year. Each student and parent will then be asked to sign an acknowledgement and acceptance of the Handbook.
